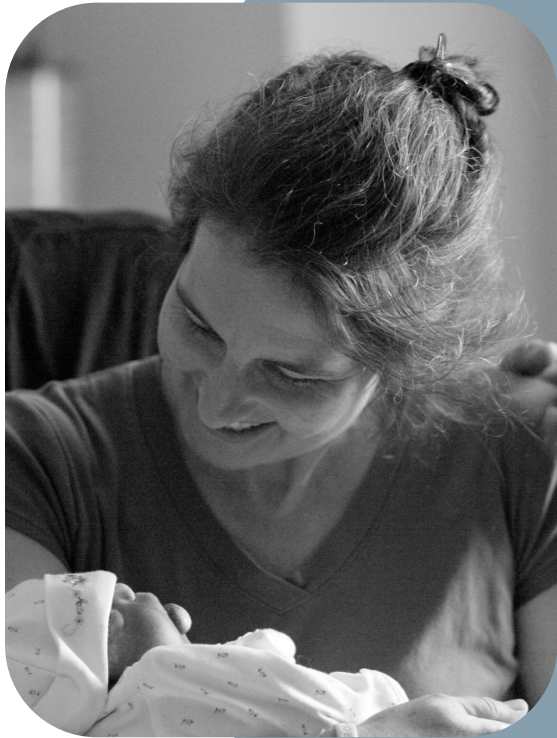




BNA Peer Ministry Training Program (Online Workshop)



This five session recorded program trains peer ministers to support parents carrying to term following a prenatal diagnosis. Power points, audio, the BNA Pastoral Care Manual, and supplemental resource materials address topics including the five themes of perinatal hospice support, pastoral care, perinatal bereavement support, spiritual support, common experiences of parents carrying to term, the importance of birth planning to include a plan for the frail baby to live, and communication.
